MUD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

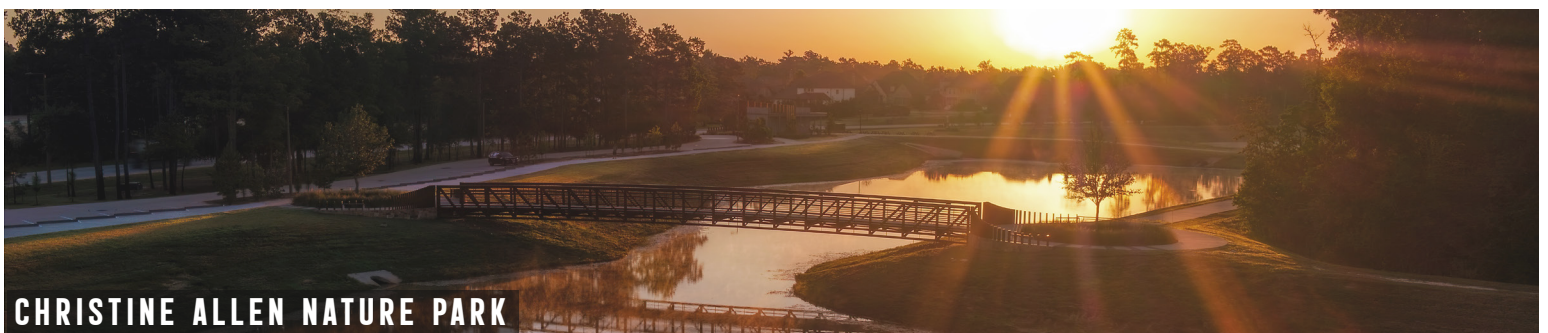
Woodforest is within a Municipal Utility District (MUD). Here are a few quick facts:
